

## Harris Employees Selected as Finalists for LEAD Brevard's "4 Under 40" Awards

While we can all name at least a few existing community leaders, how many of us know those individuals who are "emerging" in their leadership role in our community? LEAD Brevard, which provides leadership development and training for Brevard County, is helping to identify emerging community leaders through its annual "4 Under 40" awards. And this year, two Harris employees made the cut as award finalists: **Jennifer Ogburn**, Senior Engineering Manager in Manufacturing Operations, GCSD, and **Lisa Stigall**, Manager of Community Relations, Corporate Headquarters.

Nominees are evaluated on a range of criteria, including communication skills, knowledge of how the community works, originality of approaches to strengthening and transforming the community, demonstration of leadership skills, and impact on/contributions to the community.

Jennifer is an active member of the Brevard community. In the past year alone, she has organized GCSD Supply Chain Operations employees to work on the Harris Habitat for Humanity Build, participated in multiple Brevard Zoo Paws On Community Build Days, and supported Harris' K-12 Outreach initiative by volunteering with a local elementary school, among other activities. She currently serves on the Development Committee for the Brevard Zoo, helping to raise funds for the Zoo's Animal Care Center and other capital projects. Additionally, she has served as the chairperson for the Society of Women Engineer's (SWE) annual awards banquet, as a member of the United Way Community Impact Panel on Domestic Violence, and on the Harris Women in Engineering (WIE) steering committee. As a volunteer for Meals on Wheels, Jennifer has also organized successful holiday cookie and bread drives for Meals on Wheels recipients, helping Harris employees become more involved with the organization.
